Formerly *Enterprise for the Repair of Aeronautical Material* is a Romanian aircraft repair facility with some production capability for outside designs. Headquartered in [Bucharest](#), it was founded by Royal Decree in 1920 as *ASAM*, and rebranded as *IRMA* after 1944. In 1978, the company changed its name to *IAvB - Întreprinderea de Avioane București* (Bucharest Enterprise Aircraft), rebranded as *Romaero S.A.*, in 1991.

Is an aerospace company that integrates two major activities: aerostructure manufacturing and maintenance and repair for civil and military transport aircraft.

As an airframe manufacturing Part-21 (G) approved organization, ROMAERO has capabilities for tool design, production engineering, CNC machining, stretch forming, chemical milling, painting, laboratory testing and acts as a subcontractor of world well known aircraft producers such as: Boeing, Bombardier, Spirit Aerosystems, Aero Vodochody Aerospace, SABCA, SAAB and Aerolean.
